

### Annual Highlights

- 30 adolescent and women got skill training on tailoring.
- 110 farmers aware the cultivation of cash crop and got the training of papaya cultivation.
- Community were aware on use of toilet and saving of water.
- 25 people were trained on development of community based nutrition garden.
- Community were aware on tri color food intake and nutrition food.
- *Mathematics day celebrated in school to encourage the students.*
- Environment day was celebrated among the community.

### **Livelihood and Skill Development**

A initiative taken to skill up the rural women and adolescent on women tailoring. The objective was to link them with income generation activity and develop the mindset of self employment. In this connection, Organization started a training center in Bandarbasa village of Devipur block of Deoghar, Jharkhand. The total 30 adolescent and women got the training of 3 months.



After the successful completion of course in the village, organization has planned to start the training center in other village. Team started the mobilization process for the same center in Saptar Panchayat of Madhupur block of Deoghar, District.

### **Water & Sanitation**

Organization has aware the community to use of toilet and saving of drinking water. World water day was also celebrated in schools to sensitize the children on water related issues. A painting competition was also organized.



Swachta oath and Water saving oath was also taken by community. Community was also aware about regular hand washing will save from COVID 19.

### **Health & Nutrition**

Malnourishment is the major issues in rural area and it increases during this period. Community were aware on the issue of malnourishment. Trainings were provided to SHGs for identification of malnourishment, tri color and nutrients. SHG women aware the community. SHGs women were also capacitated on development of nutrition garden. 25 women developed nutrition garden.



Status of malnourishment has been improved in the area. Community are suffering from hunger and poverty due to the effect of COVID 19.

### **Environment Awareness**

World Environment day was celebrated to aware the community on protection of environment. Community were aware on more and more plantation. They were sensitized on the effect of deforestation etc.



During the day, 44 plant was planted in various villages of the devipur block, Deoghar. 20 community members participated. They took the oath to protect the forest area and aware the community to protect the forest.

### **Agriculture & Horticulture**

Income of community is essential to be increased. Community has been aware to adopt the practice of Cash crop cultivation in addition to traditional crop. In this context, 110 farmers got the technical training of Papaya cultivation.



Farmers got the technical training about timing, distance of plant, fertilizer and the required land. Farmers knew the benefit from the Papaya cultivation, They agreed to cultivate in plant with their contribution.

### **Education**

Education has very much affected from the COVID 19. School was mostly close throughout the year. Mathematics day was celebrated in school to keep the interest of children.



The total 30 children participated in the event.
